Please join us for our February luncheon meeting to be held at The University Club. Drinks will begin at noon with luncheon to follow at 12:30pm. Our speaker will be Professor Jennifer Trahan, whose topic will be "Prosecuting Genocide, War Crimes, and Crimes Against Humanity: The Weaknesses and Strengths of International Justice."

There are now a variety of international, hybrid, and domestic tribunals prosecuting genocide, war crimes, and crimes against humanity. How well does each work? Are they prosecuting crimes correctly? What are the strengths and weaknesses of the current system? Professor Trahan's talk will give an overview of the work of the International Criminal Tribunals for Rwanda and the former Yugoslavia, the International Criminal Court, the Special Court for Sierra Leone, and the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia, as well as the Iraqi High Tribunal.

Professor Trahan is a clinical assistant professor at New York University's Center for Global Affairs, where she teaches international law and transitional justice. In addition to her academic work, Professor Trahan is an independent consultant and expert in international justice. She has served as Iraqi Prosecutions Consultant for the International Center for Transitional Justice, Defense Consultant for the Sierra Leone Special Court, and both Counsel and Of Counsel to the International Justice Program of Human Rights Watch.

Our February program has been approved in accordance with the requirements of the Continuing Legal Education Board as a transitional and non-transitional program for a maximum of one (1) credit hour, which can be applied toward the CLE requirement.
